2009 SUMMER SESSION



Summer Session -

- June 1 - June 18, 2008

Classes are held -

- Monday - Friday 8:00 a.m. - 12:45 p.m.



2009 REGISTRATION



April 21 - May 25, 2009

- Students may take one class per session and earn ½ credit for the class.
- Transportation to and from summer school must be provided by the parent/guardian.
- Teacher and room assignments available the first day of summer school.



2009 COURSE FEES



- \$250.00 per course. *Payment for course required by May 28, 2009.
- \$35 textbook deposit fee. *Refundable at the end of the course when textbook is returned. Any damage to the book will result in loss of deposit.
- \$25.00 administrative fee *Only for students who do not attend TPA. Refund requests must be made by May 25th.

2009 COURSE SCHEDULE



Latin I -

Designed for new incoming 8th grade students that have not taken Latin I. Basic 1st year Latin grammar skills along with basic English grammar skills will be taught to prepare students to enter Latin II.

Pre-Algebra Readiness -

Rigorous skill based math class to prepare for TPA's 7th grade Pre-Algebra course. Recommended for incoming 6-7th graders.

Pre-Algebra -

Students begin to address mathematical concepts by using numerical analysis. They master the operations of addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division using whole numbers, fractions, decimals and percents. They move toward symbolic language and begin to understand math as more than just rote memorization of algorithms. They learn to use first order equations and inequalities to solve real world problems. *Time Permitting

Algebra I -

Students acquire more algebraic skills using and articulating the properties of real numbers. Students learn to set up and solve complex first and second order equations and inequalities. They expand their mathematical models to the coordinate plane and begin to understand functions. *Time Permitting

Algebra II -

Students more fully develop their algebraic skills and analyze higher order functions. In addition to linear and quadratic functions, students study exponential, logarithmic, polynomial, rational, and radical functions. Students begin to use the graphing calculator as a tool to solve real world problems graphically and algebraically. Discrete mathematics topics of probability, statistics, sequences and series are studied. Their studies end with proof by induction. *Time Permitting



ATTENDANCE AND CONDUCT

Attendance -

I understand:

- Only two (2) absences are allowed
- A tardy arrival or early departure of 15 minutes or more will be counted as an absence (Class times are 8:00 a.m. to 12:45 p.m. all days, EXCEPT as noted below for Final Exams)
- A student will be withdrawn from their class, receiving NO credit for the course on their THIRD (3rd) absence

Exams -

- Final exams WILL NOT be administered early by any teacher, NOR will exams be administered AFTER a session ends.

Exams will be administered on Thursday, June 18th from 8:00 a.m. to 10:30 a.m.

- No INCOMPLETE OR PASS/FAIL grade will be given for a course. Students will receive a letter grade for any course taken through the Summer School program.

Student Conduct -

Summer School students are expected to conform to the Tempe Preparatory Academy "Standards of Behavior" and "Dress Code". **ELECTRONIC DEVICES SUCH AS PORTABLE RADIOS, CD PLAYERS, ELECTRONIC PAGERS, BEEPERS, CELLULAR PHONES, ETC. ARE PROHIBITED DURING SUMMER SCHOOL SESSION.**

Students in Summer School are governed by the same rules and policies as the students enrolled in TPA. These rules are specified in the Family Handbook, which is distributed each year to all students. Students who do not normally attend TPA will receive a copy on the first day of class.



DRESS CODE AND PAYMENT



Dress Code -

Boys: Khaki pants or shorts may be worn with a dark belt. If wearing pants, dark socks must be worn with dress shoes. If wearing shorts, white socks must be worn with dress shoes. Dress shoes should not be tennis shoes and must be all one color. White or Navy knit polo shirts may be worn with pants or shorts. They must be free of any logos.

Girls: A plaid TPA uniform skirt, available at Dennis Uniform in two styles may be worn. The skirt hem should reach to just above the knee. Navy blue walking shorts may also be worn. Shorts should go to just above the knee but not below, and should not be tight fitting. A dark dress belt must be worn with dress shorts. Solid white knit polo shirts (two- or three-button, with or without a breast pocket -- no logos, except the TPA logo) or white or light blue oxford button-down dress shirts, short or long sleeve. Shoes must be low-heeled, low-soled or flat, dark, solid-colored leather loafers or dress shoes. No open-toed or open-heeled shoes or sandals. Sneakers, tennis or jogging shoes will be permitted. Girls should wear nylons, blue tights, or solid color navy blue or white socks. Socks must be visible above the shoe.

Refund, Payment, and Cancellation Policies -

- Tuition refunds due to the student's withdrawal of registration must be requested through the TPA School Office until May 25th) or by calling the Summer School office at (480) 839-3402, Ext. 101.
- The Summer School office must be contacted no later than May 25, 2009 to request a refund for Summer Session tuition.
- There will be a \$30.00 processing fee for any class registration cancellation resulting in a maximum refund of \$220.00.
- Without written authorization to do otherwise, all refund checks will be made payable to the parent/guardian signing this Registration Form and will be mailed to the student's home address listed on the other side of this form.
- A full refund will be made to those students enrolled in classes that are cancelled due to low enrollment.
- Issuance of refund checks requires 3 to 4 weeks processing.
- Any insufficient fund checks received by TPA will be charged a \$35 NSF Fee.
