In order to insure the highest level of academic success for each child, it is Tempe Preparatory Academy's policy to have regular and open communication with the student and parent regarding all aspects of the student's program.

- TPA will provide the parent(s) or guardian of the student with regular quarterly academic reports on the student's progress.
- If the student is aware of a serious academic or ongoing interpersonal problem, he or she should inform the parent or the school.
- The teacher or Head of School will communicate by phone, fax, letter or home visit if there is any concern about the student's work or deportment.
- Whenever the student is absent, if the parent has not informed the school of the student's absence, the school office will phone the parent at home or work to confirm the student's absence.
- TPA will also provide each parent with a monthly bulletin/newsletter regarding school activities.
- The parent / guardian is encouraged to contact the school and request a conference any time there might be a concern regarding their child's progress or if the child is experiencing any serious and ongoing interpersonal difficulties that interfere with his / her safety or ability to learn.

The atmosphere of TPA is intended to be safe, friendly and devoted to serious academic pursuit.

- TPA will expect high standards of personal conduct of every student, both toward adults and other students.
- School discipline procedures, as outlined in the parent / student handbook, will be fairly and consistently enforced.
- The student is undertaking a commitment to serious academic work which will require a sustained effort, both in the classroom throughout the day and in regular assignments. Parents will ensure both suitable study environment and the time for students to do homework.
- Students will be expected to participate regularly in classroom discussions and cooperative learning activities with other students.

Please note the following policy regarding TPJA.

I understand that admission into the 6th or 7th grade of Tempe Preparatory Junior Academy in no way entitles my child to preferential admission into the 7th grade of Tempe Preparatory Academy. Nor would my 6th grade child's admission into Tempe Preparatory Junior Academy provide a sibling with preferential admission into Tempe Preparatory Academy. Further, I understand that even if another one of my other children are currently attending or have graduated from Tempe Preparatory Academy, my incoming 6th grade child is not entitled to preferential admission into Tempe Preparatory Junior Academy. The two schools are distinct educational institutions, operating under separate state charters, and therefore admission into one school has no impact on admission into the other school.
